STATIC DISPLAY AT THE TANGMERE MILITARY AVIATION MUSEUM Sunday 8th August 2010

Dear

On Sunday 8th August we'll be mounting a display to accompany their Battle of Britain Memorial Day, the highlight of which will be a display by the Battle of Britain Memorial Flight, weather permitting. For this occasion exhibits should be restricted to War-Birds of the WWII era along with mid-war marques and trainers from the thirties up to that time.

During the events we'll have a thirty minute window, between 8.00 and 8.30 am during which time we'll be allowed to drive into the car park, which fronts the hangars, and unload our models. All cars must be returned to the designated parking areas by 8.45 am at the latest.

Participation in the event will, of course, allow free access to the museum.

If at all possible, please try and supply a suitable table/tables to display your aircraft. Wallpaper paste tables are ideal since they're light and fold flat. We will be able to provide some tables but cannot guarantee your models the 'table standing' which will always show them off to their best advantage. Other good ideas to enhance the display include table cloths or plastic 'tarpaulin' type sheeting for table cover and possibly a waterproof sheet to protect your model in the event of rain. An A4 or A5 sized card, or laminated paper sheet giving relevant information about you exhibit will prove most informative to our audience and can contain any information about the prototype, the model or even the builder and again a photograph either attached to, or embedded in, the **Static Display Information Sheet** will greatly enhance the presentation.

Please keep this covering letter safe for your future reference but also find enclosed, a **Model Registration Form**. This should be completed and returned to me as soon as possible, but at the latest, two weeks before the event. Please be sure to indicate the date of the display for each model you wish to register.
