This year the competition was again run over three days, three rounds per day.

On day one 9 pilots flew, the wind was 15 -20 mph. Ray Beadle had the wings fold on the tow and flew Harry Hooks model in the comp. The best times of the day were by Declan Cousins with a time of 16min.39 sec, the only one to make the 10 min max. Ray Beadle with 5min. 46 sec and K Knox with 5min.45 sec. .

Day two had winds of 8-10 mph. 10 pilots started, the best times for the day were by John Riall with 9 min. 54 sec. however in round one, he was going to make the 10 min when he flew into the line as the next model launched, got tangled up in the line and came down on the chute gently with no damage! for 8min.31 sec. Ray Beadle with 7min. 03sec. and Jeremy Stuttard with 6min.54 sec.

For day three 10 pilots flew. Ray Beadle got the best time with 11min.35 sec., Derek Honeysett with 10min 03 sec. and Bill Pethers with 8min 43 sec.

EXTREME SLOPE SOARING

While in Turkey for my Daughter-in-law's wedding earlier this month I was lucky enough to get the chance to do a tandem paragliding jump from the Babadag Mountains of south western Turkey which look out across some of the most beautiful and dramatic scenery in the world.

The tandem paragliding experience commences with an hour long drive up the mountain side to the launch platform which stands around 1750m above sea level.

After launch, pilot and passenger experience an exhilarating lift as the canopy fills with the up-draught from the mountain side. The descent to the beautiful beaches of Oludinez takes about 30 minutes on average. This is dramatically shortened when the chute is flown through diagonal loop and rotational spin manoeuvres with pilot and passenger pulling up to 5G.

Wow! What a fantastic experience with a great pilot / photographer. After the jump I bought the DVD of apps. 100 stills and a 20 minute HD video for £35 on top of the £60 I've paid for the jump. One of the best 100 quids I've ever spent in my life.



Thorney may be closed for access and flying from time to time as per notices posted Clear Dope and on the web site www.cadmac.co.uk

Pass system for Thorney Island.

The process for gaining access to the Island will be through the collection of a temporary car pass via the Main Entry Point gate post which must be returned on exiting the establishment. Temporary passes will be issued for a vehicle and its occupants provided that:

- All individuals are registered on the Club's membership list as held at the gate post.
- All vehicles are road legal and details (Make, Model, VRN) held on membership list.
- All vehicle occupants provide photo identification (driving licence or passport) to cross-reference with membership lists on entry.
- Users accept vehicle searches on entry and departure.
- The vehicle and occupants only use and park at the facility of which they are a member: other areas of the Island remain out of bounds, and military personnel will challenge breeches and are empowered to remove passes and escort non-compliant personnel off the Island.
- It is an MOD and club requirement that all members visiting the Island carry with them the current Club and BMFA cards
