In case anyone was wondering where the design for the finish on my Acro Wot came from (probably not, but I'm telling the story anyway) it actually came from a model I built in the mid-eighties called a Spirit.

A sprightly 40" aerobatic model for which I wanted a finish a little different from the classic slope back stripes sported by many aerobatic models. I can remember (unusually for me) having decided on the diamond shape, I considered having all four card suits on the wings, but for some reason, which I don't remember (usual for me), just going for stripes on the other wing.

It was a lovely little model, with I believe an Enya 19 for power and my old Fleet 35mhz 6 channel radio. Reproducing that design on the Acro Wot was just a bit of personal nostalgia. You can still get the plan for the Spirit from Outerzone.
